- Student Success Fee: \$25.00 per semester (freshmen, sophomore & juniors only)
- Student Activity Fee: \$63.72
- Technology Fee: \$171.72 (over 6 hours)
- Summer Technology Fee: \$114.50 (>3 through 6 credit hours; summer clinic/classes are 6 credit hours)
- Repair and Rehab fee: \$5.16/credit hour, maximum of \$61.92 per semester
- Online Course Fees: \$50.00/credit hour
- Parking Fee: \$160.00 for the 2016-2017 academic year
- Equipment Fee: \$250.00/semester - *This fee covers large and small equipment used by students during patient treatment. This fee is due at the beginning of each semester.*

- 2. Textbooks \$1,200.00/1st year (estimate). This cost will be lower in the second year.
- 3. Instrument Kit \$ 1, 500 (estimate)
Dental hygiene students purchase dental instruments and supplies for use in the pre-clinical and clinical classes. Kit payment is due in early August prior to the start of the fall semester in the first year of the professional program. Anticipate instrument replacement costs during the second year.
- 4. Professional Liability Insurance \$35.00 annual premium (estimate)
Dental Hygiene students are required to carry their own personal liability insurance during their second year of clinical practice due to involvement in off-site volunteer activities.
- 5. Personal Medical Insurance
Dental Hygiene students are required to carry medical insurance while in the program.
- 6. Safety Equipment/Personal Protective Equipment \$100.00/year (estimate)
Students purchase their own personal protective equipment (PPE) for use during pre-clinical and clinical courses work. PPE includes eyewear, gloves, and masks. Regulation eye protection includes glasses with solid side shields, goggles or chin-length face shields. During the first week of classes, students will have the opportunity to try the various types of PPE before making a purchase.
- 7. Uniforms \$100.00 (estimate for two sets)
Students wear scrubs and lab jackets during patient treatment. Students must purchase a minimum of two sets of scrubs and one lab coat. See enclosure for details.
- 8. Hepatitis B Vaccination
Hepatitis B vaccination = \$150.00 - \$200.00 (estimate)
Arrangements for the vaccination can be made with the Indiana University South Bend Wellness Center or your family physician.

9. Tuberculosis Test \$20.00 annually (*estimate*)
Students are required to obtain a TB skin test annually while in the dental hygiene program. Arrangements for the test can be made with the Indiana University South Bend Health & Wellness Center or your family physician.
10. Flu Vaccination \$20.00 annually (*estimate*)
Students are required to obtain an annual flu vaccination while in the dental hygiene program. Arrangements for the test can be made with the Indiana University South Bend Health & Wellness Center or your family physician.
11. Drug Screening \$35.00 annually (*estimate*)
Students are required to submit to annual drug screenings while in the dental hygiene program. Arrangements for the test **must** be made with the Indiana University South Bend Health & Wellness Center.
