Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to define the grading scale used in all courses specific to the IUSB Vera Z. Dwyer College of Health Sciences Division of Dental Education.

Policy:

All courses in the Indiana University Division of Dental Education in South Bend use the following grading scale in dental hygiene courses. ***An attainment of at least a 75%, is required to successfully pass a course.**

Grading Scale:

A+ = 97-100	B+ = 87-89	C+ = 77-79	D+ = 67-69
