### **APPLICATION TIMELINE:**

Applications available: February 1st

Applications due: April 1st

Notification of individual interviews: Week of May 24th

Individual interviews: June 1-4<sup>th</sup>

Final decisions communicated: Week of June 7<sup>th</sup> Program start: Fall 2021 semester (not summer)

# **CLINICAL COMPLIANCE:**

When students are accepted into the program, they are expected to complete and provide all required documents.

#### **GPA REQUIREMENTS:**

Application GPA: 2.50 Cumulative GPA: 2.50

If a student was granted academic renewal by the University, then the student should use the Student Undergraduate Program Summary GPA instead of the Indiana University Undergraduate Summary GPA for their Cumulative GPA.

To determine your application GPA, use the attached excel spreadsheet. You will need to include the # of credits hours earned and grade obtained in each prerequisite course.

# PREREQUISITE COURSES:

- Non-Science Courses:
  - o ENG-W 131
  - o SPCH-S 121
  - o MATH M111 or any other pre-approved course(s)
- Science Courses:
  - o AHLT-R 185
  - Human Biology Physiology (PHSL course prefix)\*
  - Human Biology Anatomy (ANAT/PHSL course prefix)\*

\*See an academic advisor for specific course options

Applicants must complete all prerequisite courses requirements by May 10, 2021.

## **APPLICATION REVIEW:**

- All applicants will be ranked based on:
  - o Application GPA (the weighted GPA of all program prerequisite courses): 45%
  - o Essay (the average of reviewers' scores): 15%
  - Course Repeat (the weight assigned to the number of program prerequisite courses that were repeated): 15%
    - 4: No repeats of any program prerequisite courses
    - 3: Repeat of 1 non-science course
    - 2: Repeat of 1 science course
    - 1: Repeat of 1 science course and 1 non-science course OR Repeat of 2 non-science courses
    - 0: Repeat of 2 science courses <u>OR</u> 3 non-science courses <u>OR</u> 1 science and 2 non science course
- The top ranked applicants (max. of 35) will be selected for an individual interview. The individual interviews will score applicants on:
  - o Knowledge of the Profession
  - o Communication
  - Responsibility/Decision-making
  - Motivation
- After the individual interviews, applicants will be revaluated for admission using a combination of scores from their pre-interview score (75% weight) and their interview rank (25% weight).

## **APPLICATION PREPARATION:**

Before you begin the on-line Radiography application, please have the following ready to upload:

- 1. Personal essay: Please describe how you selected radiology as your chosen profession and how you have prepared yourself to enter into the professional field. Per federal guidelines, all patient information must be kept in strict confidence and consequently, not shared in any manner; this includes specific details of family illnesses. The essay must be double-spaced, with 1-inch margins and 12 pt. font (1 page maximum). Please include your student identification number ONLY on the top right corner.
- 2. An unofficial transcript from institution (other than IUSB) where you are currently taking classes (if applicable): If you are currently enrolled in a program prerequisites course(s) at any another institution (not IUSB), please include an unofficial transcript from that institution (pdf format). Official transcripts are NOT needed. Once the course(s) is completed, it is your responsibility to send an official transcript to IUSB Office of Admissions by May 18, 2021. Please see the Office of Admissions website for instructions. These courses must be on your credit transfer report otherwise you will not be eligible for admission consideration.

You do not need to upload any document if you have already submitted your transcripts to IUSB and those classes appear on your transcript or you have only taken courses at IUSB.
