Bloodborne Pathogen Certification

Accessing Training

Students will need to complete the Bloodborne Pathogen Training for Non-Laboratory Staff.

Instructions:

-Please go to [One.iu.edu](https://one.iu.edu) and sign in.

-Use the search bar and type in: Expand

-Once you start the program you should see a gray bar at the top saying "All IU Expand". Click on it and select "Environmental Health & Safety".

-From there scroll down a little until you find "Bloodborne Pathogen Training for Non-Laboratory Staff". It is close to the top of the list so you shouldn't be scrolling for long.
