APPLICATION REVIEW:

- Applicants who meet all of the GPA requirements and have completed all program prerequisite courses at the time of application will be considered first.
- Applicants should complete all required General Education requirements by the program start date. It is extremely challenging to enroll in other courses during the clinical portion of this program.

RANKING:

- Application GPA (the weighted GPA of all program prerequisite courses): 30%
- Science GPA (the weighted GPA of the program prerequisite science courses): 25%
- Personal statement (the average of reviewers' scores): 15%
- Campus Enrollment (the weight assigned to the type of institution where the program prerequisite courses were taken): 15%
- Course Repeat (the weight assigned to the number of program prerequisite courses that were repeated): 15%

APPLICATION TIPS:

- Open the application in Adobe, tab through the form and type your responses. Then save and print it. Handwritten applications (other than signatures) will NOT be accepted.
- Official transcripts are NOT needed. Using a highlighter, please highlight all 10 courses listed on the 1st page.
- If you took the Anatomy and Physiology sequence at Ivy Tech; you must have completed all 3 courses (101, 102 and 201) there. You must attach an unofficial transcript and highlight the three courses.
- To determine your science and application GPAs, use the attached excel spreadsheet. You will need to include the # of credits hours earned and grade obtained in each course. Please note that the School of Nursing does not round any scores.
- The background check may take up to 2 weeks before a final report is ready. Once the background check is complete, you will need to log back into your account on the website and print the 1 page certificate (found under reports). The system will not notify you when it is complete so you will need to log back in and look often.

CLINICAL COMPLIANCE:

• When students are accepted into the program, a list is provided of all required health documents. Please plan ahead especially because a physical, drug screening and possibly vaccines are all required.
