Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to outline exam expectations.

Policy:

Class of 2027

Students must achieve an overall average of 77% on all exams (content and final) within a didactic course to pass the course. Points for course assignments other than exams (i.e., quizzes, class assignments, group work) are not calculated into the course grade until the 77% benchmark on exams is attained. Once the 77% benchmark is reached, any additional points earned by the student will be applied to calculate the final course grade. If a student fails to achieve an overall exam average of 77%, the student will receive the letter grade equivalent to the average of the exam scores and will be out of progression in the radiography program.

Exam scores will not be rounded to the nearest whole number.

Class of 2026

Students must achieve an overall average of 73% on all exams (content and final) within a didactic course to pass the course. Points for course assignments other than exams (i.e., quizzes, class assignments, group work) are not calculated into the course grade until the 73% benchmark on exams is attained. Once the 73% benchmark is reached, any additional points earned by the student will be applied to calculate the final course grade. If a student fails to achieve an overall exam average of 73%, the student will receive the letter grade equivalent to the average of the exam scores and will be out of progression in the radiography program.

Exam scores will not be rounded to the nearest whole number.

Students must not wear hats while taking an exam or quiz. Smartwatches and earbuds must be removed and all electronic devices put away. Students cannot have drinks on the table. Students cannot write down information on a piece of paper or on university property before taking an exam (i.e. table or chair). If students need to use the restroom during an exam or quiz, electronics and notes must stay in the classroom.

This policy follows R-13 and R-24, Notification for Improvement and Violation policies.
