OVERVIEW:

GPA REQUIREMENTS:

Application GPA: **2.70**

Science GPA: **2.70**

Cumulative GPA: **2.50**

If a student was granted academic renewal by the University, then the student should use the Student Undergraduate Program Summary GPA instead of the Indiana University Undergraduate Summary GPA for their Cumulative GPA.

APPLICATION REVIEW:

- Applicants who meet all of the GPA requirements and have completed all program prerequisite courses at the time of application will be considered first.
- Applicants must complete all prerequisite courses requirements by the program start date.

RANKING:

- Application GPA (the weighted GPA of all program prerequisite courses): **30%**
- Science GPA (the weighted GPA of the program prerequisite science courses): **25%**
- Essay (the average of reviewers' scores): **15%**
- Campus Enrollment (the weight assigned to the type of institution where the program prerequisite courses were taken): **15%**
- Course Repeat (the weight assigned to the number of program prerequisite courses that were repeated): **15%**
